The Year in Review

- Twenty two (22) ANNA leaders, executive staff, and industry and professional organization representatives helped to develop the Association's 2000-2001 Strategic Plan during a "think tank" session in Philadelphia.
- Dr. Nancy Hoffart completed the ANNA research project entitled "An Exploration of Nephrology Nursing Practice and Dialysis Patient Outcomes" and presented her findings at the National Symposium in Las Vegas.
- The Awards Committee, chaired by Cynthia Frazier, saw a 24% increase in applications for scholarship/fellowship awards and achievement awards. Once again, over \$100,000 in grants and awards were made available to ANNA members.
- The *Core Curriculum for Nephrology Nursing, Fourth Edition*, edited by Dr. Larry E. Lancaster, was published in April, 2001.
- The Advanced Practice SIG task force developed the first draft of the *ANNA APN Standards of Care and Professional Performance*.
- ANNA membership exceeded 12,000 under President Jean Nardini.
- The 32nd National Symposium, held at the MGM Grand Hotel in Las Vegas, attracted a record attendance of about 2,300 paid registrants and more than 250 exhibit booths.
