The Year in Review

- The association celebrated its 25th anniversary of service to the nephrology nursing community.
- Involvement in the national health care reform movement was very strong, including representation at the National Nursing Summit on Health Care Reform.
- ANNA released a Patient Classification System.
- The association provided representation for the First UNOS/DOT Public Forum on Transplantation.
- ANNA initiated revisions and expansions of the Quality Assurance Guide for Nephrology Nursing and the Core Curriculum for Nephrology Nursing.
- The association conducted a 2-day Strategic Planning Think Tank in Philadelphia and a 2-day "Team Think" session with ANNA committees in Dallas.
- The association's 25th Anniversary National Symposium was held in Dallas.
- Membership grew to an all-time high of over 9,000 under President Terran Warren Sims while chapters expanded to more than 100!
