Dear Chairman McGovern and Ranking Member Cole:

On behalf of the 48 undersigned organizations representing the Nursing Community Coalition (NCC), we request your support of Bustos Amendment #257 to H.R. 2500 - National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020. Bustos Amendment #257 would recognize nurses who served as members of the United States Cadet Nurse Corps during World War II and provide them with honorable discharges, medal privileges, and burial benefits for cemeteries administered under the Department of Veterans Affairs. As a coalition representing the cross-section of nursing education, practice, research, and regulation within the nursing profession, we fully support this amendment and urge you to make it in order.

From 1943 to 1948, nearly 120,000 nurses answered our nation's call and honorably served to care for our servicemen and women during World War II. As the average age of these nurses increases, it is imperative that this amendment moves forward to recognize their invaluable service.
