HEALTH POLICY UPDATE: November 30, 2022

Congressional Schedule:

• The Senate convened at 10 a.m. Following leader remarks, the Senate will resume consideration of the Schumer, D-N.Y., motion to invoke cloture on the nomination of Camille L. Velez-Rive to be a U.S. district judge for the District of Puerto Rico. At 11:30 a.m., the cloture motions on the following nominations will ripen: Velez-Rive, Anne M. Nardacci to be a U.S. district judge for the Northern District of New York, Jerry W. Blackwell to be a U.S. district judge for the District of Minnesota, and Doris L. Pryor to be a U.S. circuit judge for the Seventh Circuit. At that time, the Senate will vote on agreeing to the Schumer motion to invoke cloture on the Velez-Rive and Nardacci nominations. If cloture is invoked, all post-cloture time will expire at 2:15 p.m., and the Senate will vote on confirmation of the Velez-Rive and Nardacci nominations.

- The House reconvenes at noon for legislative business. The chamber is expected to
 consider a resolution (H J Res 100) that would resolve the current rail labor dispute and
 an enrolling resolution (H Con Res 119) that would provide paid sick leave for rail
 workers. The House is also expected to take final votes under suspension of the rules on
 14 bills.
