## HEALTH CARE POLICY UPDATE: JUNE 8, 2022

## **Congressional Schedule:**

- The Senate convened at 10 a.m. Following leader remarks, the Senate will resume consideration of the Schumer, D-N.Y., motion to proceed to the veterans' toxic exposure benefits bill (HR 3967). The Senate is expected to agree to the motion to proceed to HR 3967 by voice vote, and Sen. Tester, D-Mont., will offer the Senate substitute amendment no. 5051 to the bill. The Senate will then proceed to executive session. At 11:30 a.m., the Senate will vote on confirmation of the nomination of Lisa M. Gomez to be an assistant secretary of Labor and on confirmation of the nomination of Nina Morrison to be a U.S. district judge for the Eastern District of New York. Additional votes are expected.
