HEALTH POLICY UPDATE: August 3, 2022

Congressional Schedule:

• The Senate convenes at noon. Following leader remarks, the Senate will be in a period of morning business until 1:30 p.m., when it will proceed to the consideration of the treaty (TD 117-3) admitting Finland and Sweden to NATO, with three hours of debate equally divided between the majority and minority leaders or their designees. The chamber will consider the Sullivan, R-Alaska, amendment no. 5192 and the Paul, R-Ky., amendment no. 5191 to the resolution of treaty ratification. At approximately 4:30 p.m., the Senate will vote on agreeing to each amendment and on agreeing to the resolution of ratification.
