• The Senate convenes at 10 a.m. Following leader remarks, the Senate will resume consideration of the nomination of Arianna J. Freeman to be a U.S. circuit judge for the 3rd Circuit. At 11:30, the Senate will vote on the confirmation of the Freeman nomination and on agreeing to the Schumer, D-N.Y., motion to invoke cloture on the nomination of Lara E. Montecalvo to be a U.S. circuit judge for the 1st Circuit. Following votes, the Senate will recess until 2:15 p.m. for weekly caucus lunches.
