FOR THE MEMBER WANTING TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

1 Understand the Criteria and Requirements

Visit annanurse.org/BOD and review the criteria:

- ✓ Full ANNA Membership for the past 4 years.
- ✓ RN certification in nephrology (e.g., CNN, CDN, CNN-NP).
- ✓ Minimum 3 years of nephrology experience in the past 6 years.
- ✓ Baccalaureate or advanced nursing degree preferred.
- ✓ A minimum of 2 years experience within the last 6 years displaying leadership skills.
- ✓ Compliance with ANNA policies (e.g., conflict of interest)

2 Explore Board of Directors Opportunities

Start building leadership experience by volunteering:

- ✓ Contact your local chapter or ANNA National Office.
- ✓ Join committees, become a Specialty Practice Network (SPN) leader, or contribute to the Nephrology Nursing Journal Board.
- ✓ Participate actively in chapter events (minimum 50% participation).

3 Prepare for Application

Demonstrate leadership and dedication:

- ✓ Keep an updated resumé or CV highlighting nephrology and leadership experience.
- ✓ Attend ANNA National Meetings to network and learn about BOD expectations.
- ✓ Develop skills in governance, collaboration, and communication through existing ANNA roles.

4 Submit Your Application

Apply online via the ANNA website:

- ✓ Complete the Candidate Online Application by the stated deadline.
- ✓ Review the Campaign Regulations policy to ensure compliance during the nomination process.

5 Stay Engaged Before & During Voting

Understand the selection process:

- ✓ The Nominations Committee evaluates candidates based on performance in previous roles.
- ✓ If not selected, review feedback and focus on areas for development.

6 Participate as a Board Member:

If elected:

- ✓ Commit time for preparation, travel, meetings, and projects.
- ✓ Adhere to ANNA policies and uphold the mission of advancing nephrology nursing.
