## REVERSAL OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS' DECISIONS

## **POLICY**

The Board of Directors (BOD) may reverse its own decision by a Passing Vote either at a BOD meeting or in writing. The National President may interrupt the implementation of a BOD decision based upon additional information or changing influences.

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1. The BOD may reverse its own decision by a Passing Vote either at a BOD meeting or BOD conference call.
- 2. If the National President determines that an action should not be carried out due to circumstances arising after the BOD decision was made and that the situation is an urgent one, they will stop the implementation of the decision and notify the BOD within twenty-four (24) hours. The National President will then convene a meeting of the BOD to reconsider the original BOD decision. This meeting may be by phone, virtual, email, or in person.
- 3. Decisions made by the BOD may be reconsidered at the discretion of the National President only if a significant amount of new information is made available, or if a majority of the BOD votes to re-address the topic.
